




**Does He Know You?**

# **1. Confessors and Possessors**




## **Romans 10:9-10**

**[9] because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. [10] For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.**



**The Kurios or Lord has control over  
his possession.**




**Matthew 6:6**
