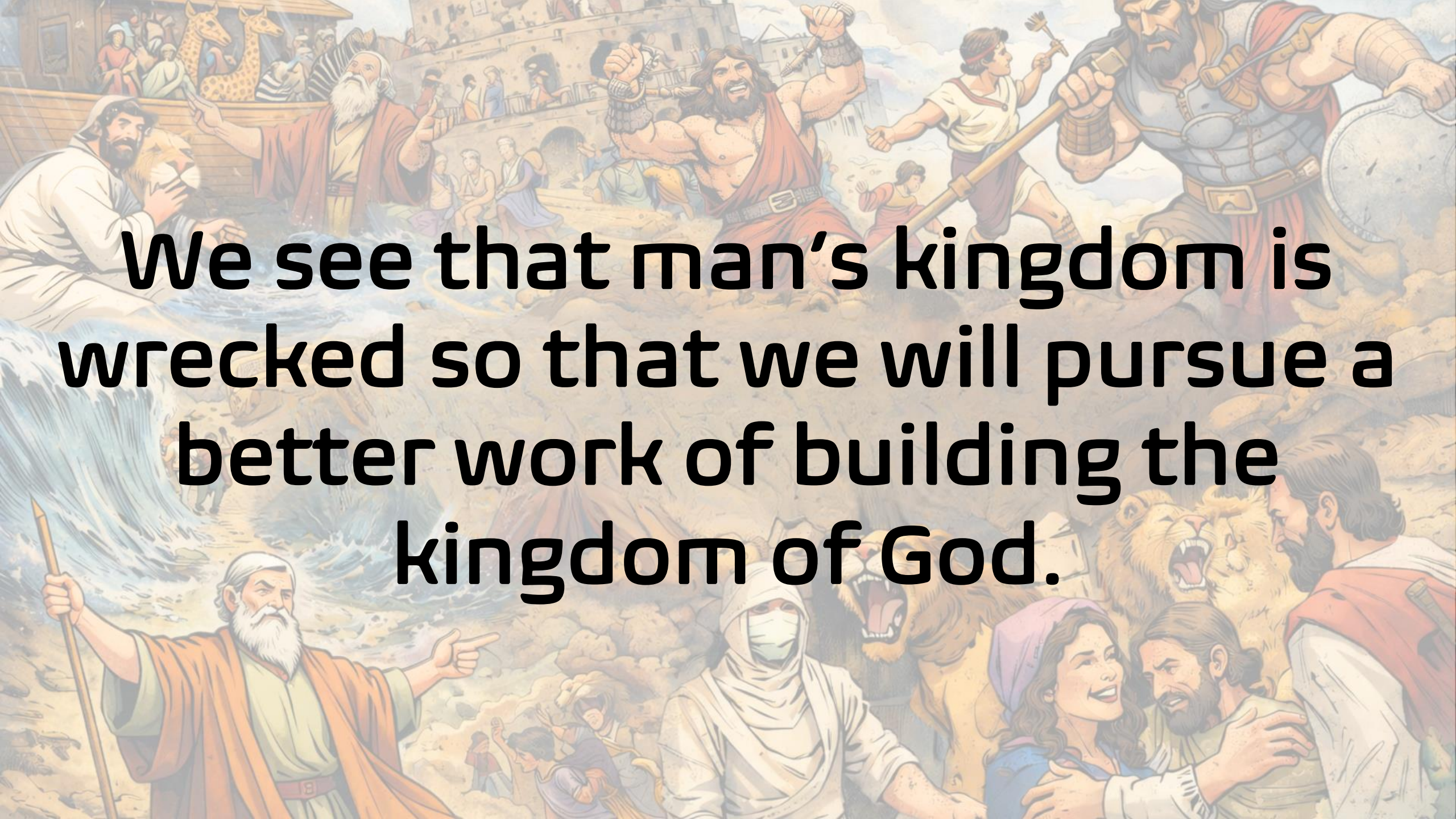




Kingdom Come


Genesis 11:1-9




We see that man's kingdom is wrecked so that we will pursue a better work of building the kingdom of God.

1. Building the Kingdom of Man

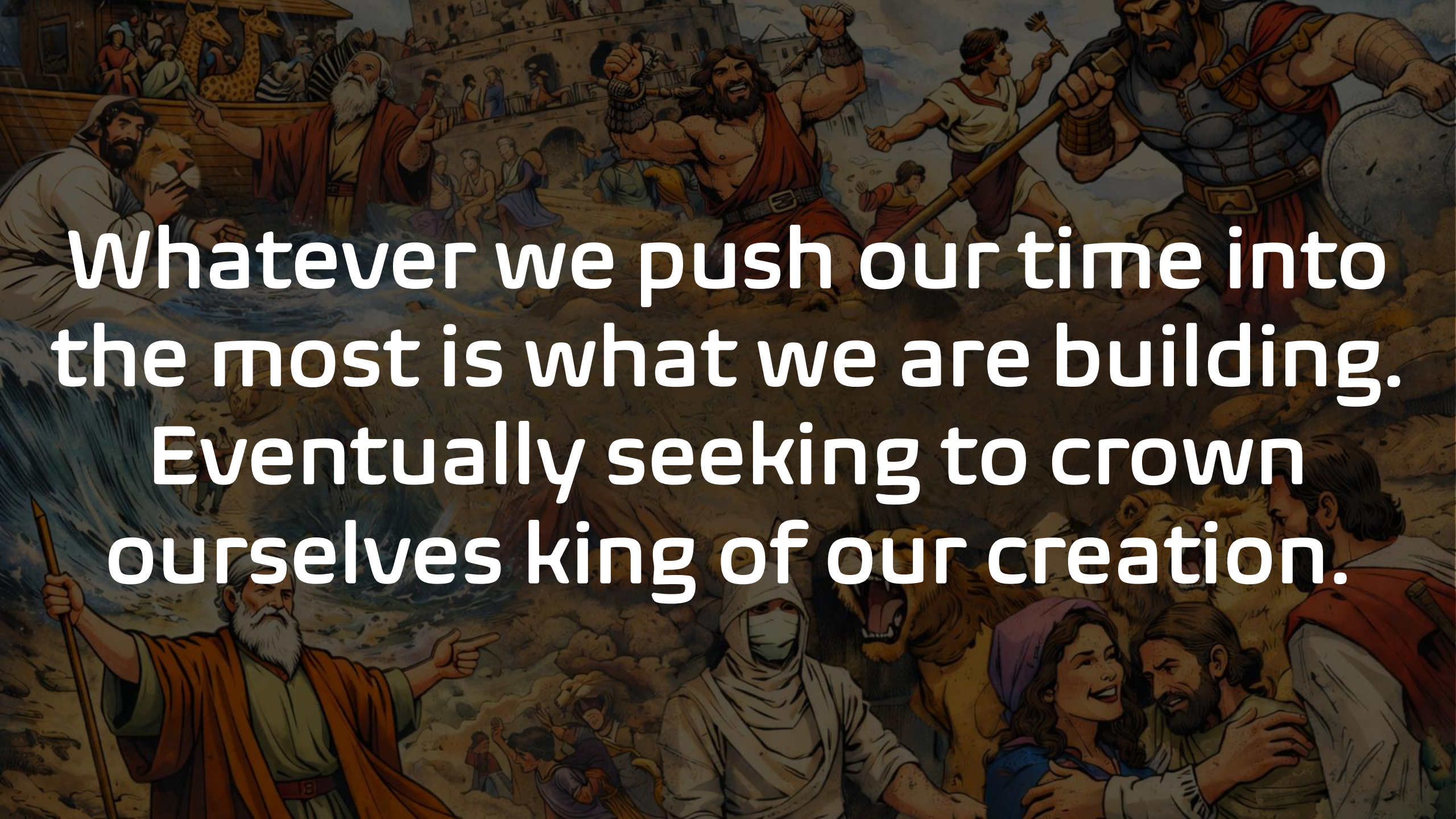

ourselves king of our creation.

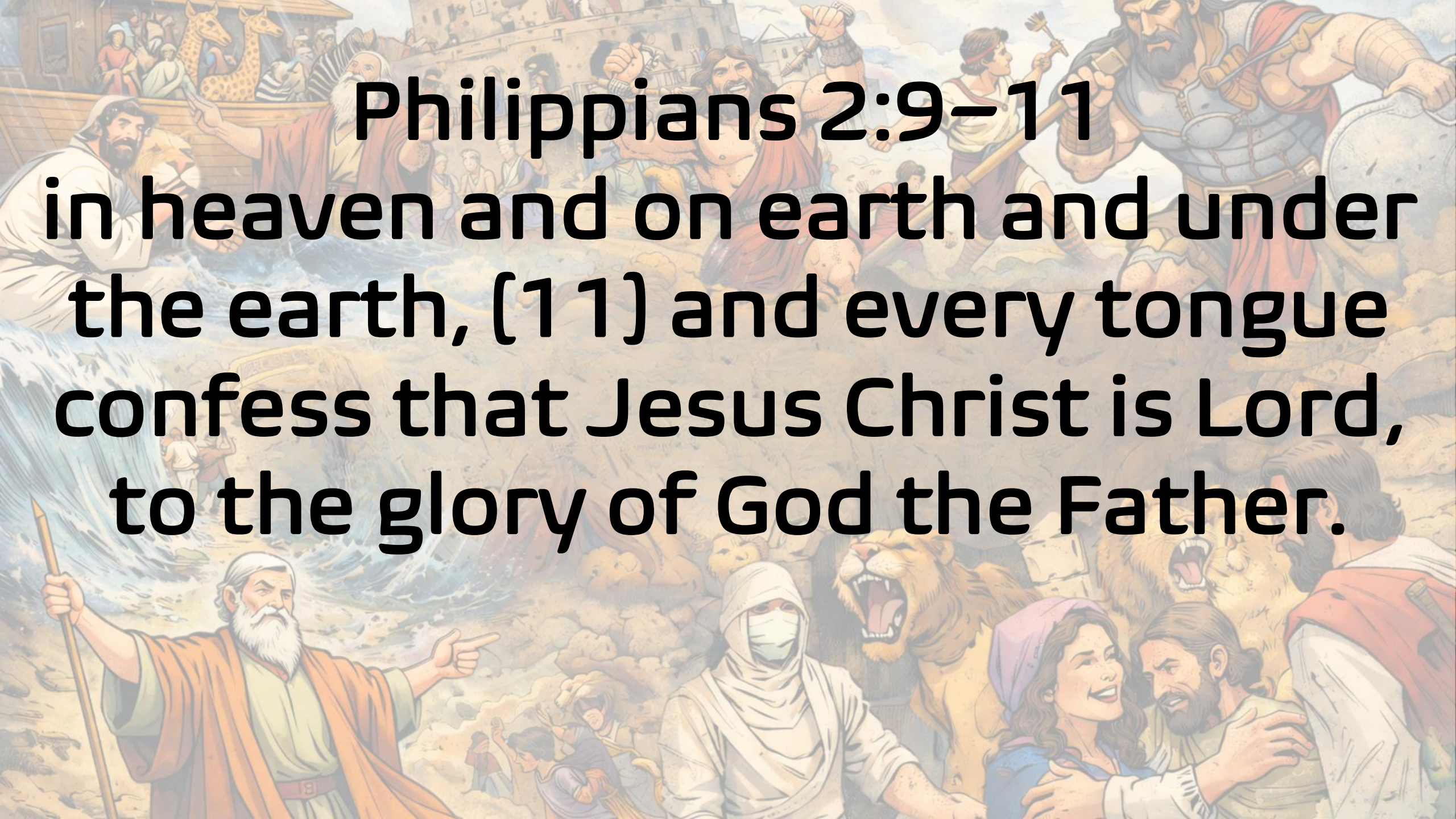


What is the kingdom that you are trying to build for yourself?

(9) Therefore God has highly exalted him (Jesus) and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, (10) so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,

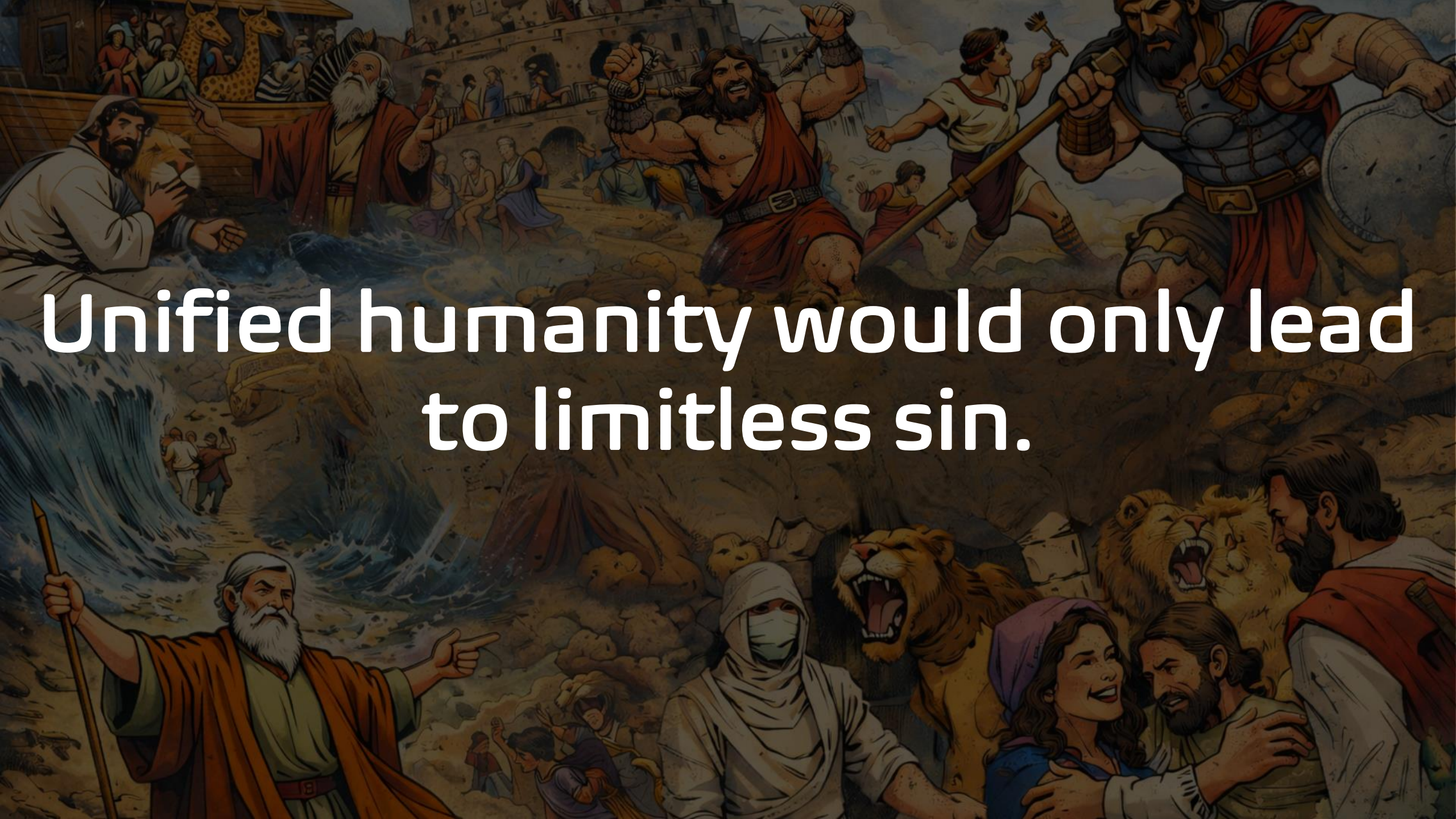

to the glory of God the Father.



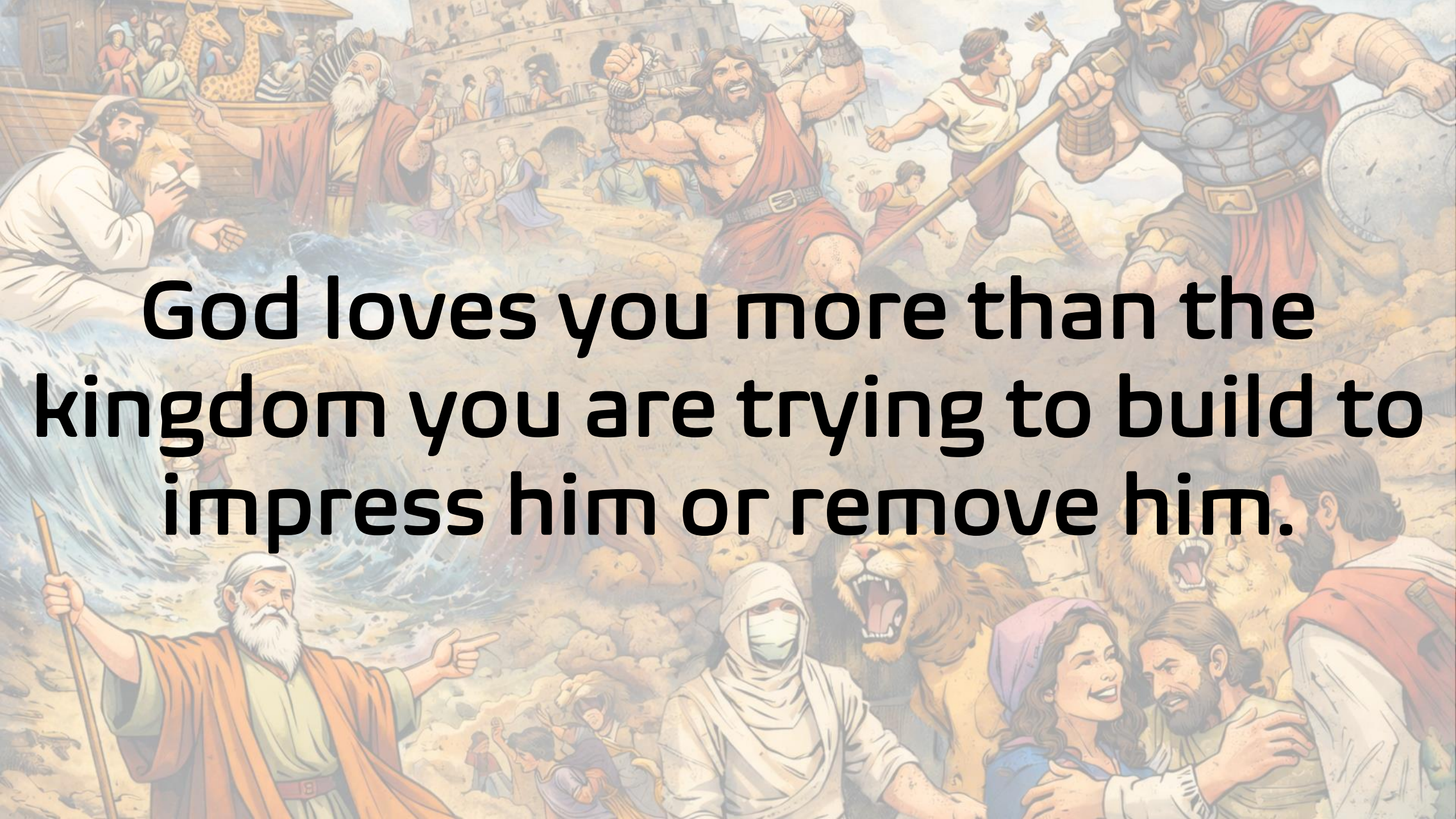




Unified humanity would only lead

God rejects the kingdom of man. In fact, Jesus begins his earthly ministry by stating, "repent for the kingdom of God is at hand."




God loves you more than the kingdom you are trying to build to impress him or remove him.
