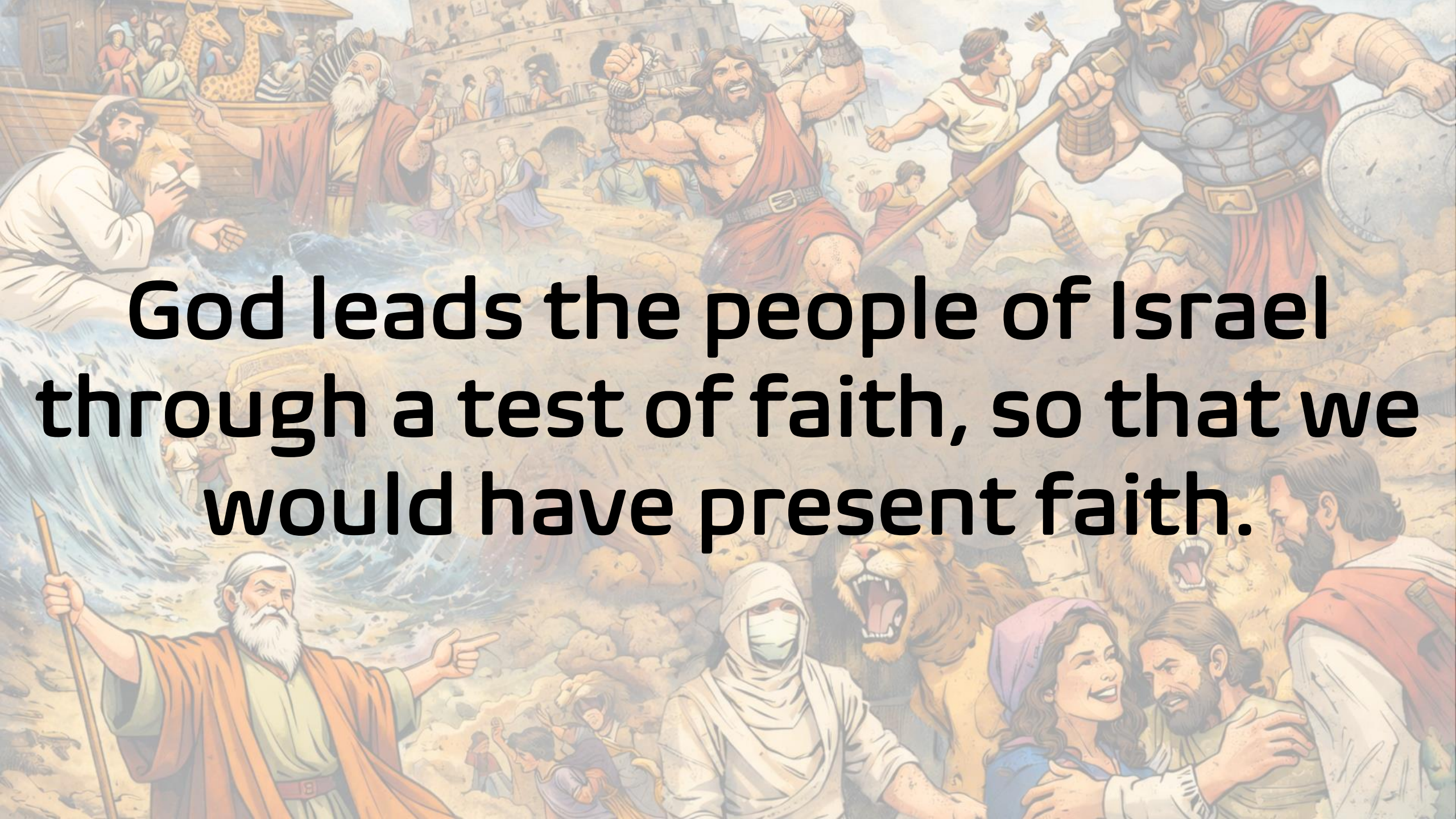

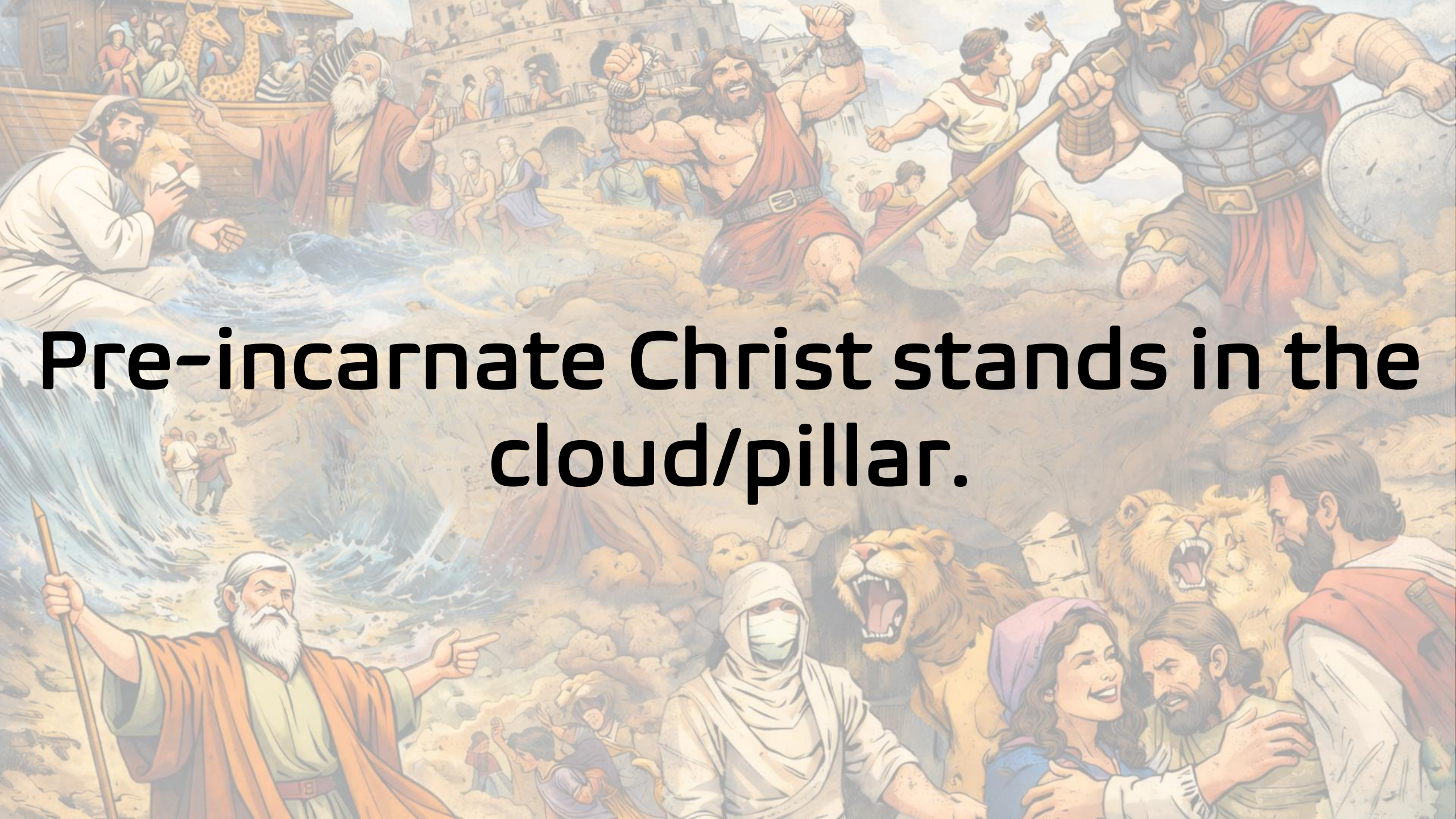

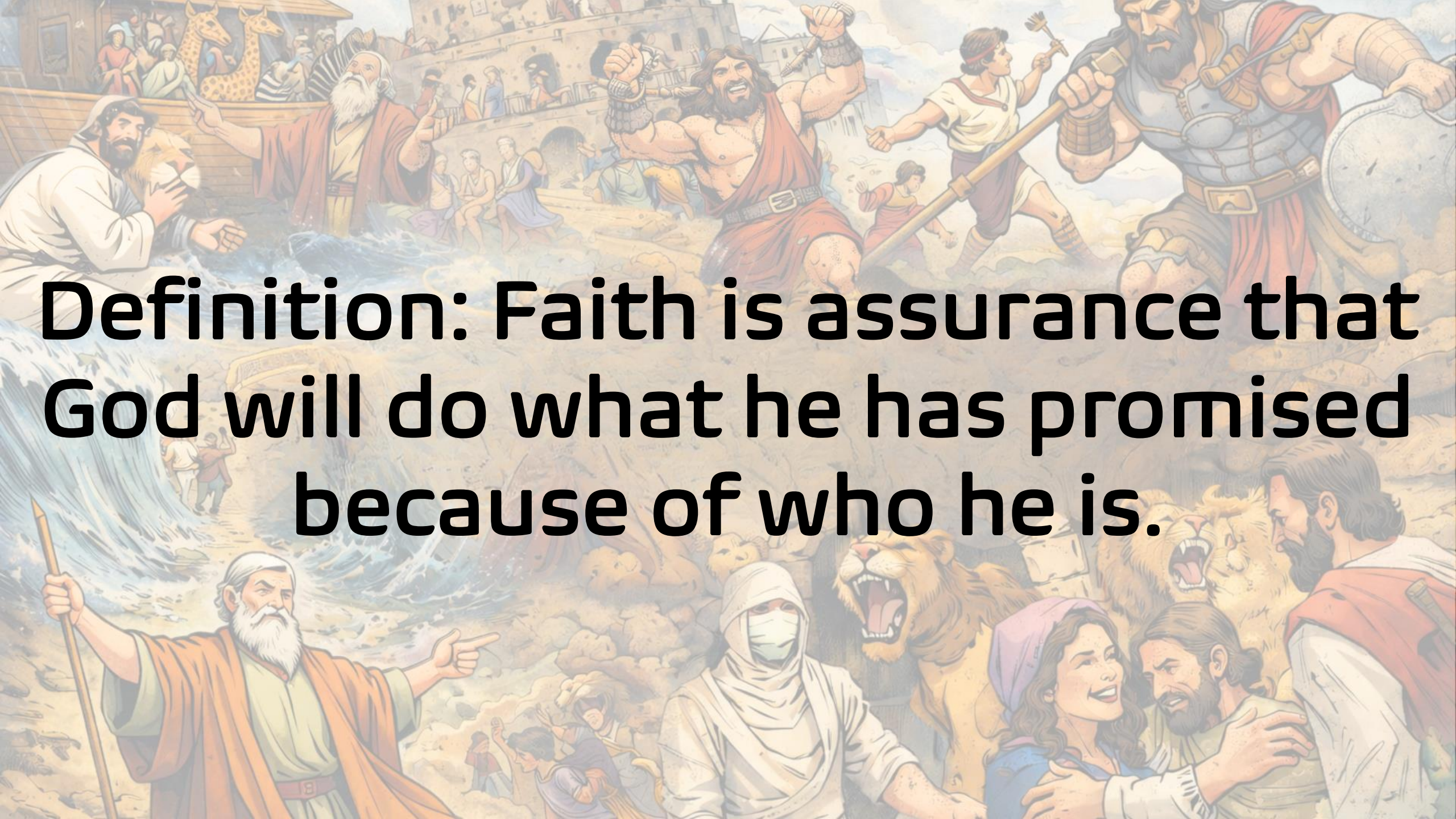

For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

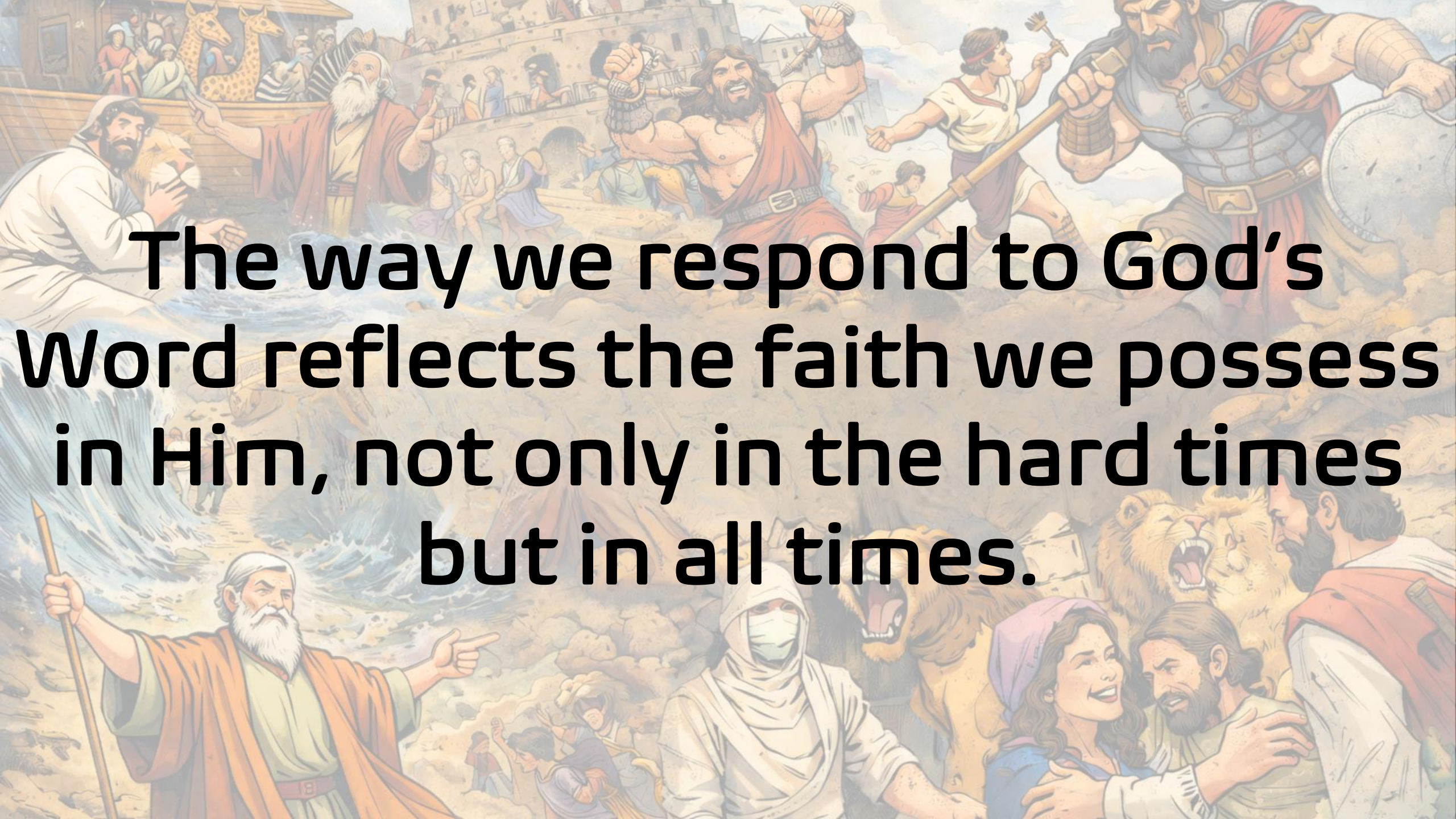


## Romans 9:15–18




Luke 9:28-31, 32-35

(28) Now about eight days after these sayings he took with him Peter and John and James and went up on the mountain to pray.

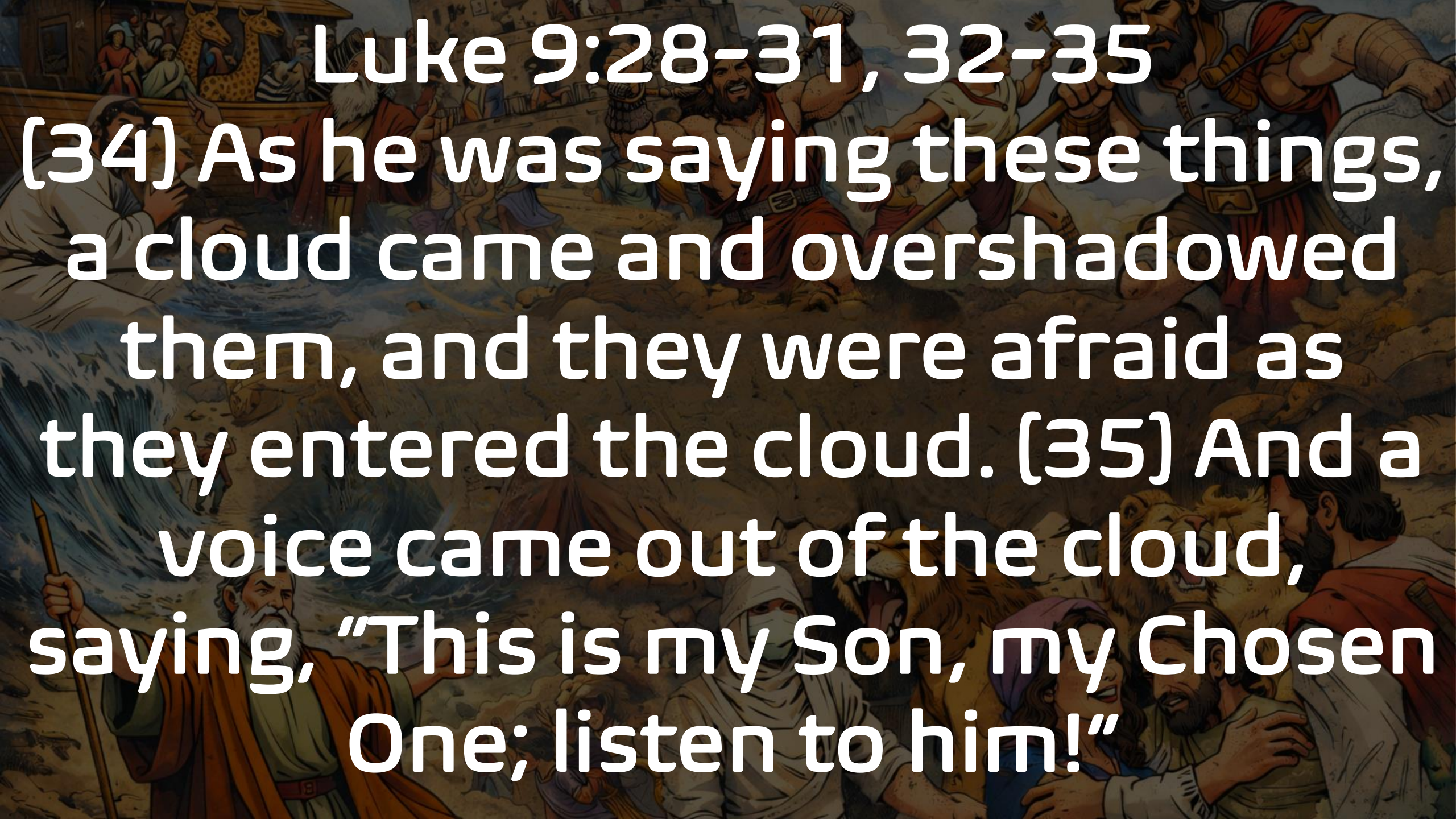
(29) And as he was praying, the appearance of his face was altered, and his
