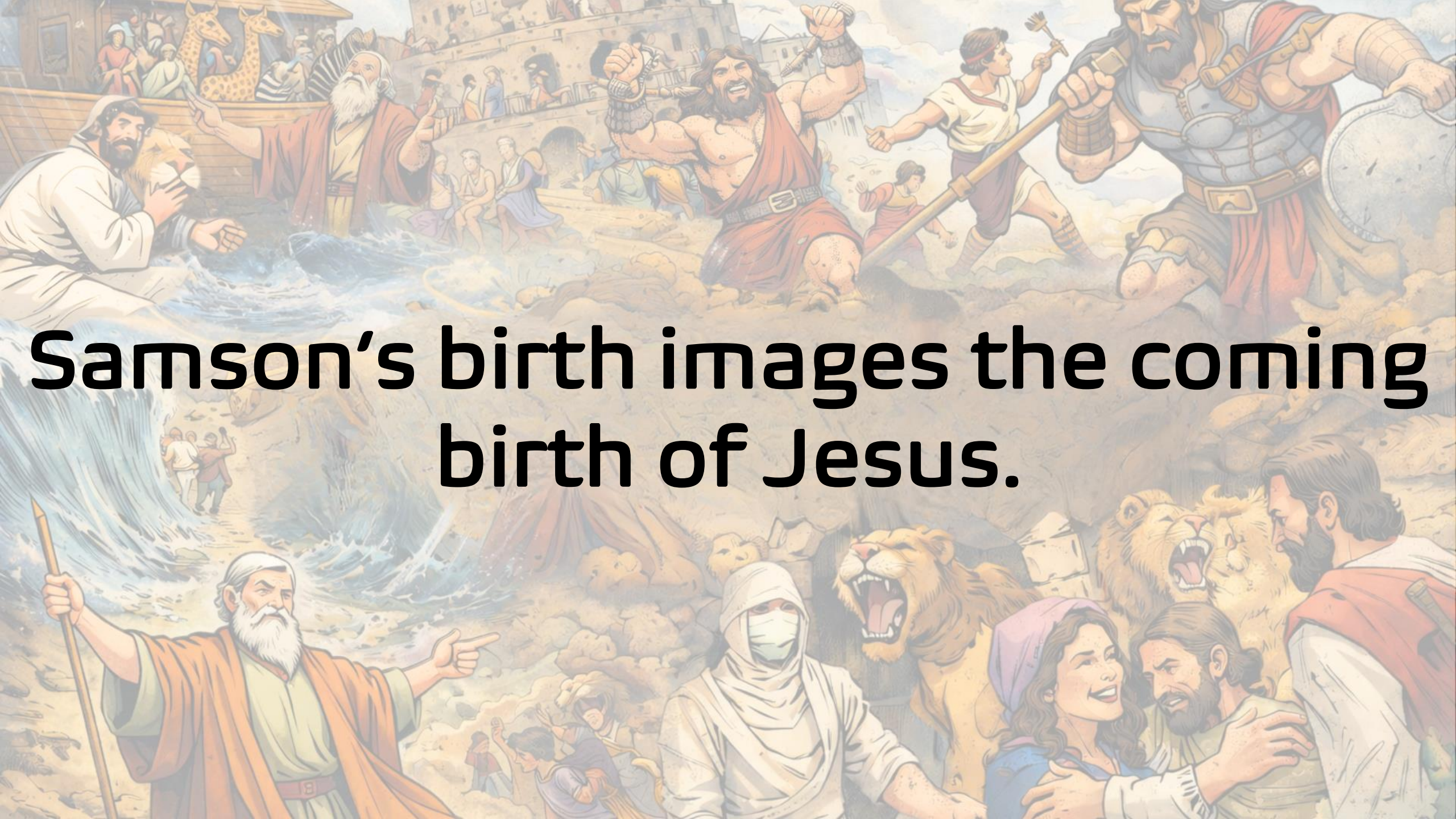

1. God Provides a Deliverer

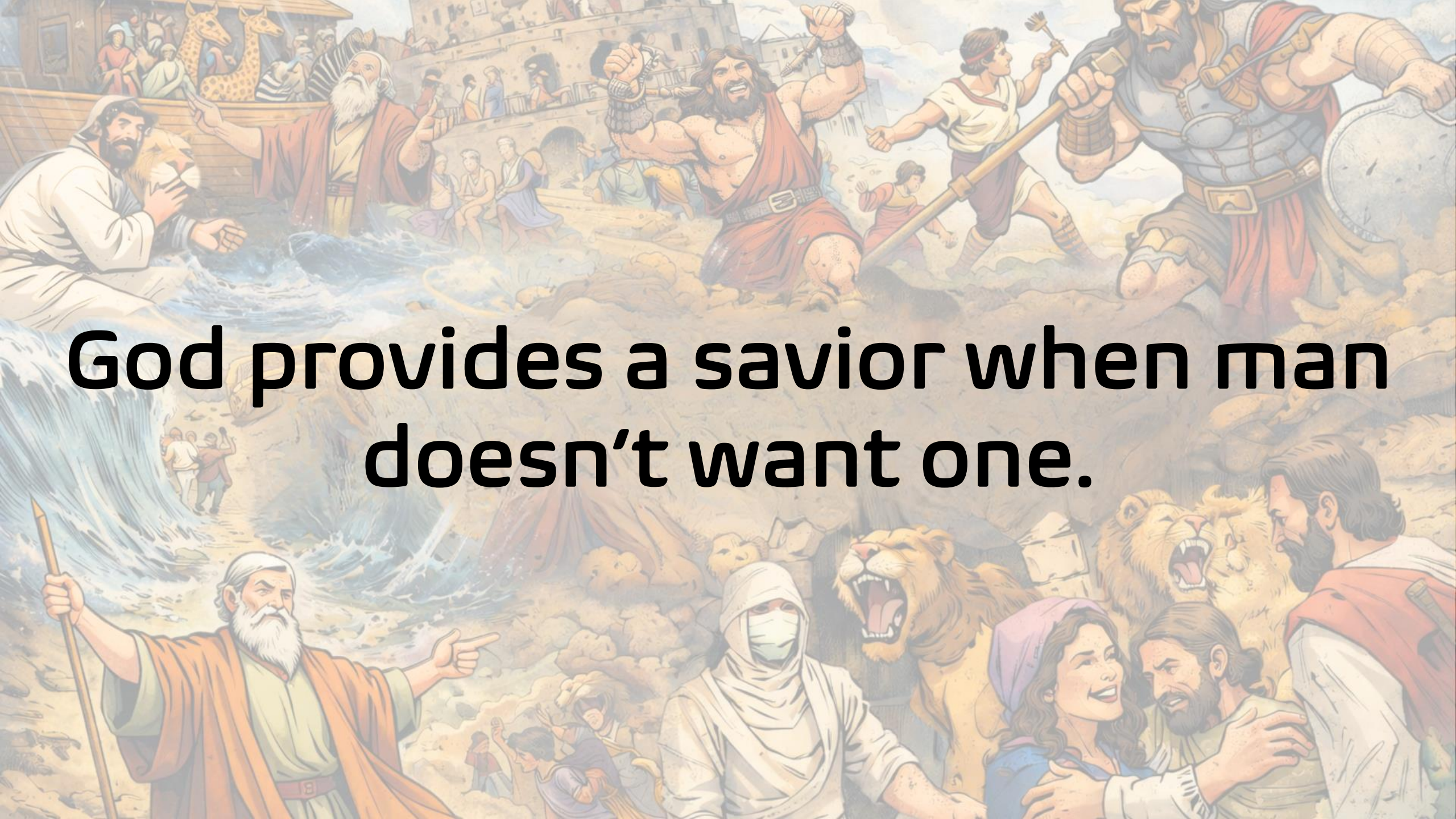




We are content in sin when

God.



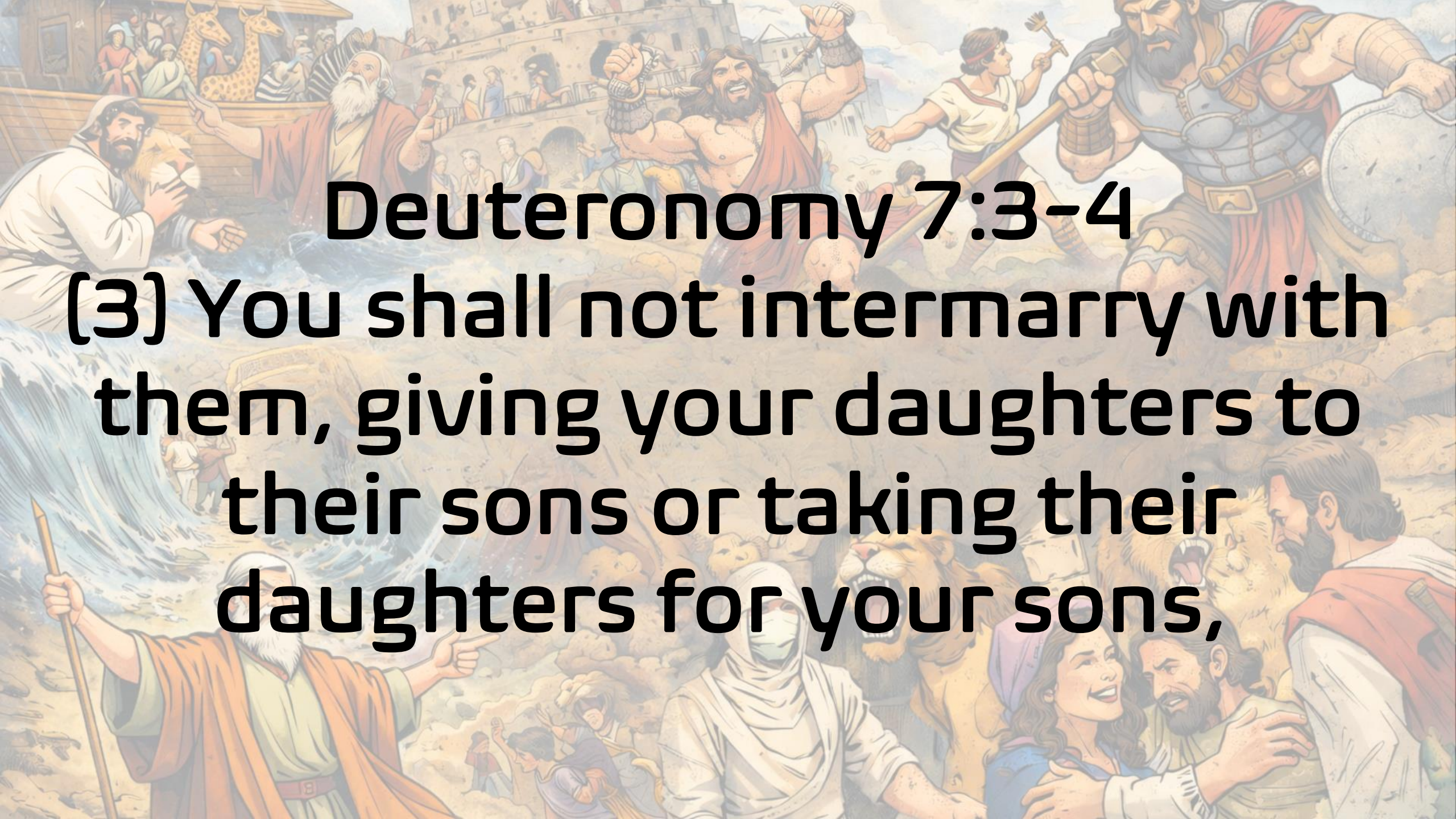
Samson's birth images the coming birth of Jesus.

2. Our Sin Necessitates a Deliverer




Deuteronomy 7:3-4

(3) You shall not intermarry with them, giving your daughters to their sons or taking their daughters for your sons,

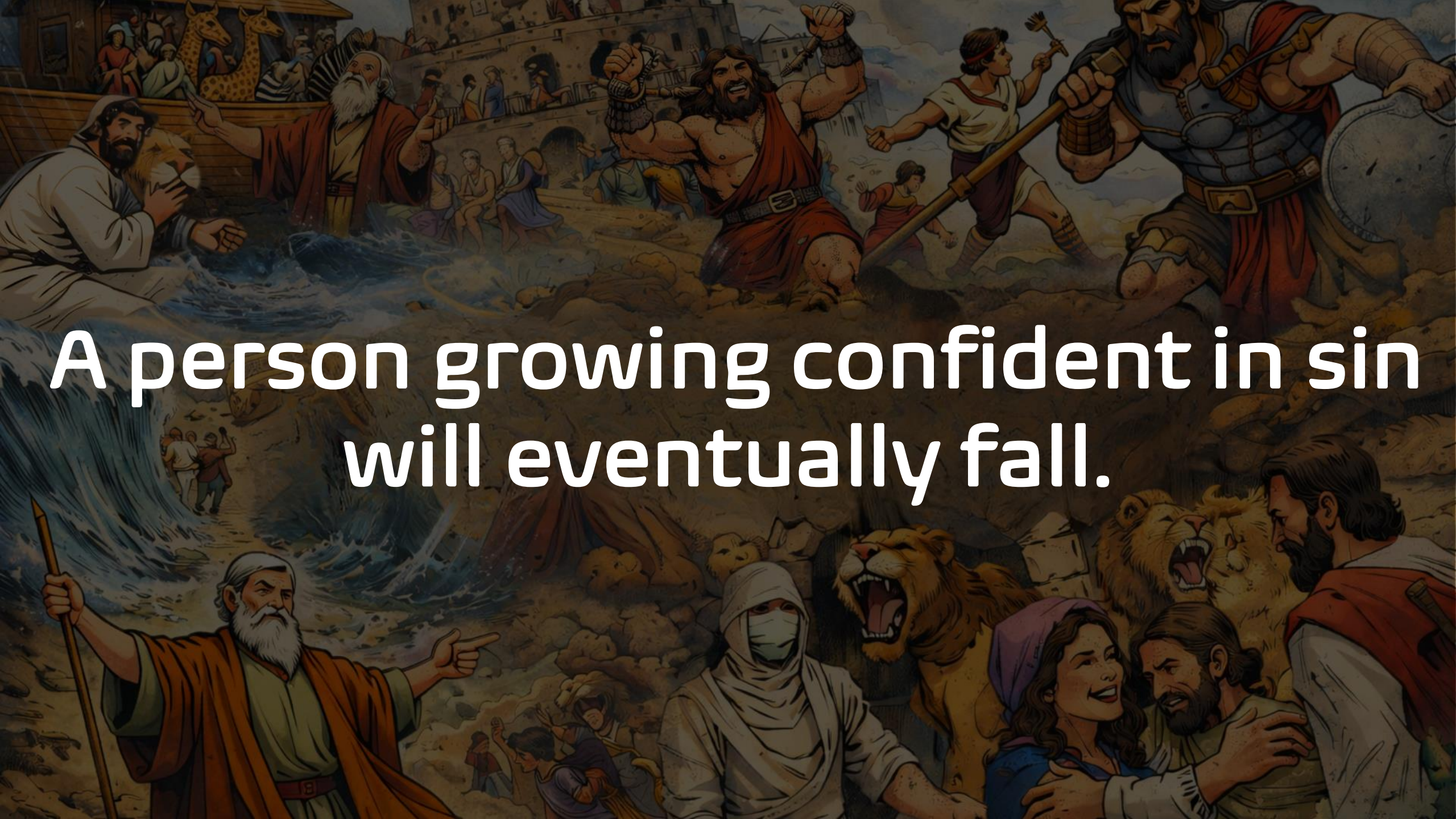


Deuteronomy 7:3-4

Hebrews 2:17

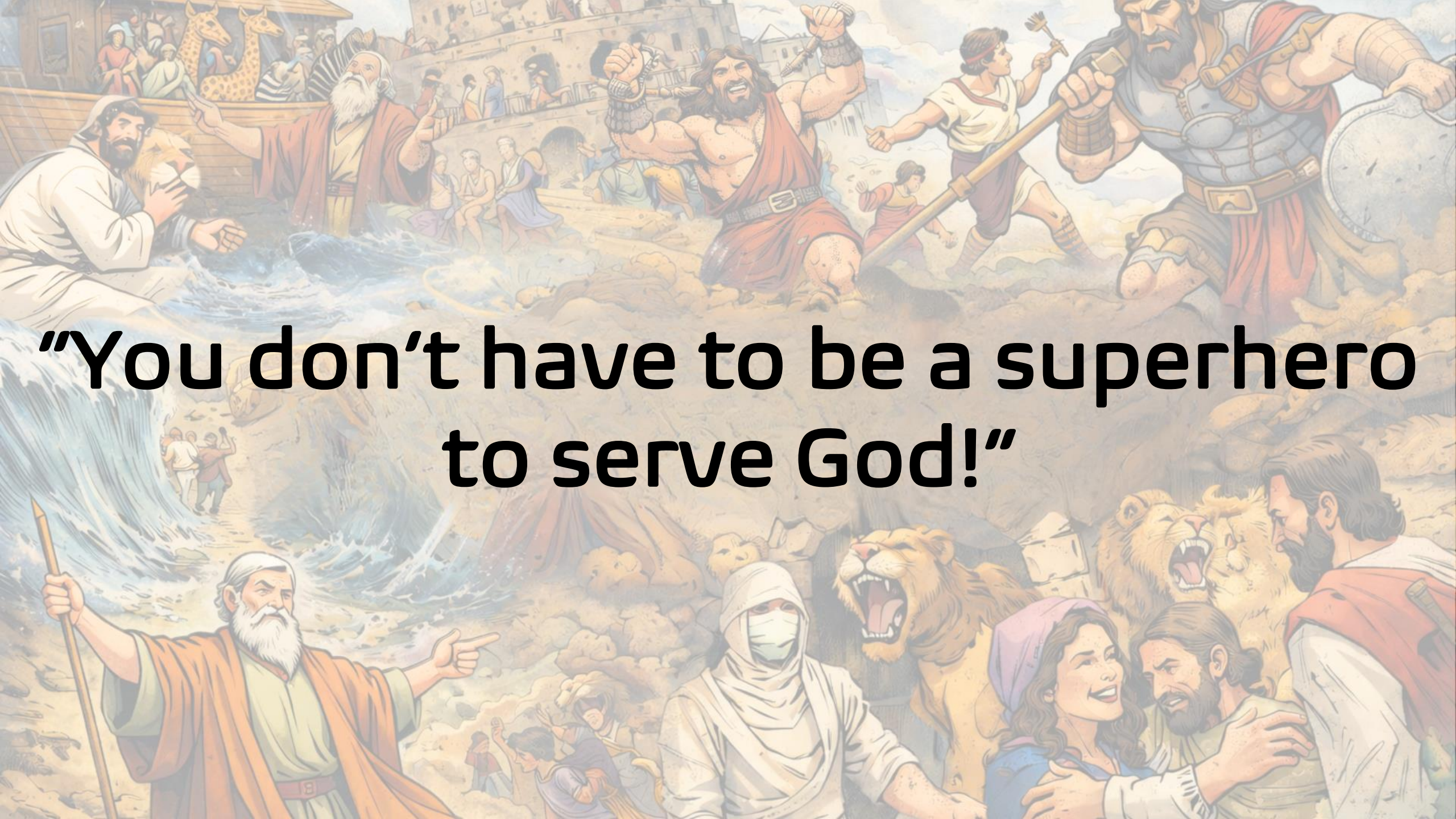
Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.
